DRESS CODE FOR COURSE AND PRACTICE FACILITIES

Proper golf attire is required at the Seminole Legacy Golf Club for all Golfers and Volunteers.

Men: shirt with collar; or mock turtle necks shirts, slacks or Bermuda-length shorts.

Women: shirt with collar if shirt is sleeveless or shirt that has no collar must have sleeves (or both), skirts, slacks or Bermuda-length shorts.

No denim slacks, skirts, T-shirts or shorts of any kind are permitted. No tank tops or muscle shirts. Only non-metal spiked golf shoes to be worn on the course.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

As a guest of the Club, we politely ask you to:

- Fill all divots with sand provided on carts
- Bunker rakes left outside the bunkers
- Repair all ball marks, yours or others'
- Keep carts out of rough as much as possible
- Carts must return to path 50 yards from green
- Observe all signs to help protect the tees and greens
- Treat your golf course with care
- Shout "Fore" when a ball heads towards a private residence

FOOD SERVICE WAIVER

If an outing client wishes to bring donated food, whether breakfast, lunch or dinner, then a Food Service Waiver Fee will apply.

A charge of \$3 per player for breakfast, \$5 per player lunch or an \$8 per player dinner will be billed. All donated food must be accompanied by the necessary food preparation and dining service equipment/supplies. Client is responsible for all clean-up.
